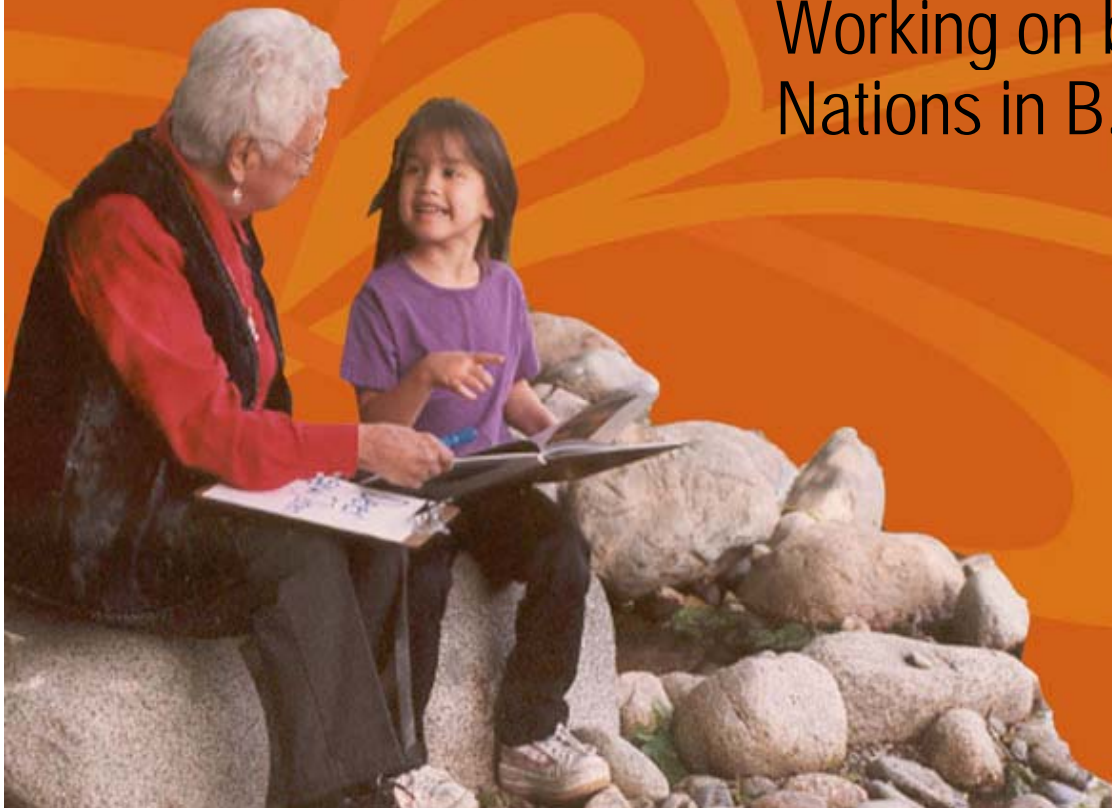

# ***FIRST NATIONS TECHNOLOGY COUNCIL***

Originally created by Summit Resolution to develop a Technology Plan for all First Nations in B.C. to address:

- high speed connectivity
- technical skills development
- technical capacity building; and,
- promoting the use of technology to revitalize culture and language

Later Resolutions passed by FNS, UBCIC & BCAFN

- development of an integrated data/information management system
- set up a Common Services Organization
