## RESOLUTION #0602.12

**SUBJECT: ESTABLISHMENT OF A FIRST NATIONS TECHNOLOGY COUNCIL**

---

### WHEREAS

There is a need to develop technological capacity and skills among First Nations in British Columbia.

### THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

1. That the First Nations Summit Chiefs in Assembly hereby establish the First Nations Technology Council and that the Task Group members appoint members to the Council.
2. That the First Nations Technology Council's mandate is to develop a First Nations Technology Plan for First Nations in British Columbia which will address technology issues, including:
  - a) high speed internet connection;
  - b) technology skills development;
  - c) development of technical support.
3. That the First Nations Technology Council seek support from the federal and provincial governments to develop the First Nation Technology Plan.
4. That the First Nations Technology Council provide written progress reports to each session of the First Nations Summit.




