SUBJECT: EXPANSION OF THE MANDATE OF THE FIRST NATIONS TECHNOLOGY COUNCIL

- A. The First Nations Technology Council was established by Resolution #0602.12 and was mandated to address high speed internet connection, technology skills development and development of technical support.
- B. First Nations need as many tools as possible to help them to revitalize culture and language.

That the First Nations Summit Chiefs in Assembly hereby expand the mandate of the First Nations Technology Council to include promoting the use of technology as a tool to support the revitalization of culture and language in all First Nation communities in British Columbia.
